We are also active in hosting visiting student study tours and professional development groups from overseas to experience life and study at CPIT. CPIT has developed fee-paying inbound study abroad and dual-degree concepts with partner institutions, and is an attractive destination for students seeking to combine their studies with experiencing the scenic, sporting and cultural opportunities available in Christchurch and Canterbury.

Current Examples / Past Examples	CPIT has a growing interest in facilitating opportunities for international staff mobility beyond traditional modes such as

study leave or collaboration in research. CPIT currently hosts visiting staff and trainees from its network of partner institutions, including a successful collaboration with Lanzhou City University in Gansu Province, China which takes place under the auspices of the wider Christchurch-Gansu sister-cities link. We are also exploring opportunities for staff collaboration and mobility through the Global Education Skills Alliance (GESA) initiative, of which CPIT is a founding member. CPIT staff also participate in offshore skills development and consulting within the applied higher education and related industry sectors.
